

## Bundeena Maianbar Football Club

### Self Registration Guide

Please follow the following instructions to register online for our club:

***NB – if you are a SENIOR (18 or over) and are a full time student, please attend a registration session with your full time student ID to obtain the \$20 student discount.***

#### 1. Login:

- a) Go to the MyFootballClub website: [www.myfootballclub.com.au](http://www.myfootballclub.com.au)
- b) Click on “Register Now”
- c) Select “Player Registration”
- d) Follow the prompts to proceed to login pages, find your FFA number and/or reset your password
- e) Login using your FFA number and password:
  - **FFA Number**
  - **Password**

#### 2. Start Registration

- a) Once logged in, select “Make a Registration” or “Register Now”
- b) Update contact details if necessary.
- c) If the player is registering for Under 10s or older, you need to have a valid photo. If you already have a photo in the system, check it is up to date (less than 5 years old). If you need to upload a photo, have an appropriate photo (less than 1MB in size) ready in a file on your computer.

Click ‘Update’ then ‘Choose file’. Select an image. Click ‘Save and exit’.

***NB: You can re-enter the system and update a photo later, but be aware that your player’s card will not be issued until you have a valid photo.***

- d) On the next screen, enter the club name (**Bundeena Maianbar Football Club**)  
***NB: If you get a message saying there are no packages then click OK and check the club name***
- e) Select the Registration role as: “Player”  
***NB: If this is the first time you have registered to play football in Australia you will need to confirm whether you played in another country***
- f) Select the correct Registration Package that applies for your registration. Click the “Add” button.
- g) If you would like to purchase uniform items select these from the list of add-ons.

If you are claiming the FAMILY DISCOUNT (3<sup>rd</sup> and subsequent players within one family – defined as parents/guardians and dependent children) select ‘FAMILY DISCOUNT’ from the list of add-ons. Click ‘Add’. The total amount owed should now be reduced by \$20.

***NB: only claim the family discount if you are eligible. All registrations are individually checked and if you have not paid the right amount, your registration will not be processed.***

- h) Click the Next button at the bottom of the screen.
- i) Read and acknowledge all the Terms and Conditions then click “Next”.
- j) Click on “Pay Now” to pay online with a credit card or select “manual Payment at Club” if you want to pay at our club rego/information day.  
***NB: Payment must be made before a registration can be accepted.***
- k) Answer the questions on the final page and click the “Save All Answers” button.

Your registration has now been submitted. Make sure you have paid your fees (see next section) and completed any necessary ID checks, etc. When your registration has been accepted by the club (once payment is received) you will receive an email informing you.

### **3. Payment options**

If you have opted for manual payment, your options are:

- Attend one of the registration days (see website) and pay by cash or cheque.
- Speak to the registrar about organizing a payment plan if you have financial difficulties.

### **4. New players only – sighting of ID documents**

If you are registering with BMFC for the first time, you will need to provide the following ID documents:

- (a) Proof of age – eg Drivers License, passport, birth certificate, school ID card
- (b) Proof of residence – eg Drivers License, electricity/water/phone bill, rates notice, tenancy agreement.

Please bring these documents to be sighted by our registrars at one of the registration sessions (see website for dates). The documents must be sighted and the document numbers recorded.
